#### Background to the Trust:

The Trust was established under the Will of Mrs Geraldine Elsie Downes on her death in December 1969. Mrs Downes named the Trust in memory of her father E. Phillips Oppenheim, the author, and her son, John Downes. Each year the Trustees distribute income from the Trust.

#### **Awards**

The awards may be made to deserving artists of any kind whether writers, painters, sculptors, musicians, dancers, actors, craftsmen or artists of any comparable nature or description who are unable effectively to pursue their vocation by reason of their poverty.

#### Eligibility criteria

The Trustees are limited by the terms of the Trust to making awards only to persons who fulfil the following criteria:-

- 1. Over 30 years of age on December 1<sup>st</sup> in the year in which the application is made and
- 2. Be British Subjects born within Great Britain, Northern Ireland, the Channel Islands or the Isle of Man.

It was Mrs Downes' particular intention to benefit persons who believe in life after death but the making of awards is not restricted to such persons.

#### **Guidelines to making applications**

Applications for an award will be considered by the Trustees after a written application has been made on the attached form. Completed application forms <u>must</u> be received by the Trustees by OCTOBER 5<sup>th</sup> and no applications received after that date will be considered for an award in that year. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that the application is received by the Trust before the closing date. The Trustees and their advisers will then consider the qualifying applications and make such further enquiries as they deem appropriate.

- There must be no more than 3 supporting pages to the application form
- Completed applications will be photocopied in a run and circulated amongst the Trustees. Please, therefore, do not provide any papers with double-sided text or graphics
- Receipt of completed applications will not be acknowledged
- All applicants should include a stamped addressed return envelope which will be used to notify you of the outcome of your application

The Trustees will aim to make the awards during the first half of December and successful applicants will be notified by post shortly thereafter. The Trustees require successful applicants to confirm in writing, by the end of September in the year following receipt of the award, how the award was used and what success, if any, had followed from it.

No examples of an applicant's work should be forwarded with the Application Form and no correspondence regarding the Trustees' decision can be entered into with applicants.
